This study aims to determine students' perceptions of using the Google Meet application for learning English in class X SMA Negeri 3 Jambi City. Because we know, the covid-19 has hampered all activities outside the home, one of which school being carried out online. The research methodology in this study is qualitative research desain whose analysis requires in-depth observation. The subjects in this study were students of class X MIPA 2 SMAN 3 Jambi City, was used purposive sampling totaling 6 students as participants consisting of two students from low scores, two students from medium scores and two students from high scores.. In collecting data, the researcher gave interviews in class. The results showed that class X students of SMA Negeri 3 Jambi City had network difficulties in learning English using the Google Meet application, however, students also found it easier to learn English using the Google Meet application because of the flexible time and being able to find their most comfortable place in language learning English. Google meet application can be implemented went the teacher wants to teach material, can share the screen with students to show the learning material. Sometimes the teacher also gives time for students to interact in the meeting room such as conversations, dramas and so on.

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CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Research

They need applications that are easy to use, interesting, and can be used offline. After the teachers have implemented by using Google Meet application, the researcher was interested in the students' opinion regarding the case.

CHAPTER II

REVIEW OF THE RELATED LITERATURE

2.1 Definition of Perception

Gibson and Reed from the Journal of Nursing de Mareno (2013:35) state that perception is an interpretation of the types of psychological traits or values that arise from the human senses. This information is then processed by human neural and mental processes to search for, download, organize, and modify the information.

Michaels and Carello (1981: 2), Perception is the final spectacle obtained by stimuli that provoke disturbance and memory expression. This stimulus is obtained through the five human senses: touch, sight, smell, hearing, attention, and interpretation. Therefore, perception is the opinion of each person who is different and not one thought.

Perception is the process of gathering information about an individual's social life (Forgus, 1996). In social life, every day people relate to other people. This form of interaction leads to the vision of objects that are perceived by the five human senses. Meanwhile, according to Robins (1999: 124), is the process by which an individual organizes and interprets sensory impressions to give meaning to the environment.

Demuth (2013: 5), perception can be divided into two forms: positive and negative. People tend to perceive positively or like and react based on their perceptions. Cognitive object. If this is not in accordance with the assessment, it

is considered a negative perception or a tendency to avoid, reject, and violate the subject's perception.

It is a psychic or mental process in which a person reacts to what they hear, see, and feel by using their senses to interpret and give meaning to individual impressions of an object.

2.2. The Process of Establishing Perception

Perception is triggered by the presence of an object; without objects, perception is impossible. Visual perception is the most common type of perception because it can be seen directly with the eye. Impulses or stimuli received by the five senses initiate a perception (sight, hearing, smell, touch, taste).

Perception, on the other hand, also refers to facts that are transmitted to the brain. In human action, perception arises from sensitivity to nature or a new reality (Demuth, 2013). It has to do with people's perception of the world. Everyone has thoughts to consider. As a result, human intellectual perception becomes the subject of perception. As a result, perception has the ability to control how humans perceive an object.

2.3 Types of Perceptions

1. Positive Perception

Perception can show the meaning of the overall knowledge and the response that will be followed by its function. It will continue to accept of support the object.

2. Negative perception

Negative perception is the whole knowledge and response that is not in line with the object being perceived. It will lead to a response that rejects or opposes an object.

2.4 Student's Perception

Learning, according to Brown (2007:19), is a process that involves going from not knowing to knowing, transferring knowledge from the teacher to the students, and delivering education to pupils. Before beginning to teach, a teacher must create a learning implementation strategy in order to make the teaching learning process more structured and efficient.

There is a phrase for learners, sometimes known as "students," in the field of formal education in elementary school and high school. Students are children

that require guidance from their teachers as educators at school in order to educate them to become adults and realize their full potential through education.

Students' perception is a process of students' treatment on information about an object, in this case in the Google Meet App (mobile dictionaries) in learning online at school through their observation with sense that they have, in this case is through application obtained from spoken and written, so that the students can give meaning and interpretation of the observed object. Thus, student perception is the response of various students' thinking to something based on their point of view.

2.5 Definition of Google Meet

According to Niko (2020) Google Meet is an application that can support communication needs anywhere and anytime with many people without having to meet the body in person23. This application is for video conferencing, it can easily be installed on the following features: Computer (Personal Computer) with webcam, Laptop with webcam, and Android smartphone

"Google Meet" as it is called, this application is very suitable for conducting Video Conferences, with the light bandwidth used, there are no advertisements in the application, and does not consume too much memory resources when running on Android or Computer.

Since the internet there is communication so it's very easy, the delivery of messages can be conveyed in a relatively short time. The Internet is a communication medium that makes it easy for users to communicate with close people and humans from other parts of the world. Onno W. Purbo means that the

internet with its various applications such as Websites, Volp, E-mail, on dasa rnya is the medium used to streamline the communication process. Internet technology has emerged as a multifunctional medium, especially in the world of learning. Communication via the internet is tried interpersonally or en masse, which is known as one to several communication (mailing list). The internet can appear in real time audio-visual as in conventional procedures with the presence of a teleconference application. In the educational process, technology certainly requires, whether cellphone, laptop or PC, educational technology continues to grow. But in principle, technology can be grouped into 2: technology based learning, and technology based website learning.

Technology based learning consists of audio information technologies (radio, audio, tape, voice mail, telephone) and video information technologies (video tape, video text, video messaging). On the other hand, technology based learning is basically information technology information (bulletin board, internet, email, tele-collaboration). 26 The Google Meet application can be downloaded directly via the Google Playstore on your smartphone. This software supports 3G as well as 4G wireless networks. The use of the internet is also useful to support the improvement of the quality of education that is tried remotely. Distance education fits the conditions of Indonesia, an area spread over thousands of islands. Therefore, its existence is accommodated in the National Learning System which was ratified in July 2003, specifically article 31 of Law number 20 of 2003.

2.6 How to use Google Meet

Google Meet can communicate directly with anyone via video. In addition, users do not need to download the application, they can directly join the meeting just by clicking on the link provided. In their daily activities, teachers already use Google, but not all teachers understand how to use Google Meet to support teaching and learning activities. Here's how to use Google Meet on a Laptop: 1. Open a Gmail Account in a browser. 2. Select 'Start meeting' to start the call or select 'Join meeting' (code required). 3. After entering the video, you can click 'Join now' and can enter the code to invite other participants.

2.7 Advantages and Disadvantages of the Google Meet Application

Sutirman (2013: 63), learning has two advantages. Web-based, i.e. platform and classroom freedom. For this reason web-based learning offers a high degree of flexibility in case the settings, structure and content change according to the needs and characteristics of the user.

One effort to make content available to students while studying online is to use video conferencing applications such as Zoom Meeting and Google Meet. Basically, a web video conference is a one-to-one video call. That is, one person can add or invite many people to a video call, and all participants can watch the video displayed by the video organizer (Michael Gough, 2006: 223). This application allows both teachers and students to face each other and facilitate the learning and teaching process.a. The atmosphere is similar in class. This is because we can see directly (live) the faces of our teachers and friends who are appearing in the class or forum.

There are seven advantages to using Google Meet: 1. You can connect different schools and cooperate in education. 2. Students do not have to leave home to take lessons. 3. You can repeat the learning completed by the recording function. 4. Communicate with people who are familiar with your field. 5. Educational and learning processes can be carried out outside class hours. 6. Helps connect teachers and parents 7. Reduces education costs.

In addition to the disadvantages of online learning, its weaknesses are an argument that needs to be considered. drg. Indah Suasani Wahyuni (2020: 11) also explained that there are problems arising from the use of video conferencing. 1. Internet service provider coverage issues. The internet signal may not cover all areas or the signal you are getting may not be good. 2. Use more bandwidth or quota. 3. Not all educators can have creative ideas when applying online learning pedagogy. 4. The cost of using the Internet is a burden for both teachers and students.

2.8 Previous Studies

There are some previous studies which are relevant to this study.

The first research was done by Shakizat Duisenbayeva, G. K. Kassymova, Azman M.N.A. His research was conducted in (2019) entitle "The Trend in Using Online Meeting Applications for Learning During the Period of Pandemic COVID-19: A Literature Review". This study is carried out to examine the trend in using online meeting applications to learn during the outbreak period. This study was conducted using qualitative methods through descriptive analysis of the results of observations and documentation. This scenario shows the increment of the usage of

these applications in the teaching and learning process (P&P). The use of this application is very helpful in the teaching and learning process between teachers and students. Overall, there is an increasing trend and give the effect towards usage of online meeting applications in solving learning problems in the future.

Second, the research was done by, Amrizal, Zohri Hamdani, Roldan C. Cabiles. Their research was conducted in (2019) entitled "google meet app as a learning media in increasing students' writing skills during pandemic". This study used action research. It has four step in conducting, among others are planning, implementing, observing and reflecting. According to Burns (2010), action research is intentionally plunging into a problem to solve a problem which aims for change and repair in applicationand aims to improve by introduce more potent teaching investigations (Stone et al ,2009). There are 23 students as population of this study, they are 9students in the second semester, 6 students in the fourth semester and 8students in the sixth semester. To take sample used cluster sampling, the second semester is as sampling here. The technique of data collecting used pre test and post test and the analysis data used average score.

Third, the research was done by Aswir, Muhammad Sofian Hadi, Fatimah Rosiana Dewi(2019). "Google Meet Application as an Online Learning Media for Descriptive Text Material". This type of research is qualitative research. While the method uses the descriptive method. Descriptive research is research that aims to describe an event and its characteristics and is more directed at the "what" question (Nassaji, 2015). The purpose of this study is to describe online learning held in class 10 IPS 4 MAN 4 Jakarta using Google Meet media. This research was designed as

a descriptive study. This study involved the researcher who carried out an internship at MAN 4 Jakarta in the odd semester of the 2020/2021 school year and taught English subjects in class 10 IPS 4, in which there are 30 students.

The similarities my research and previous researcher is Google Meet,

Qualitative Research Desain, analisys, observation, interview.

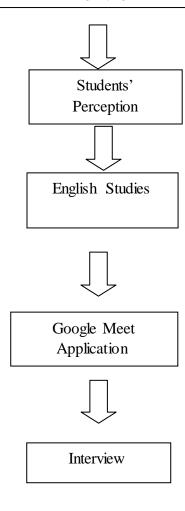

CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHOD

3.1 Research Design

This study was used a qualitative research desain whose analysis requires in-depth observations. This study provides an overview of the phenomenon of the situation that occurs by learning English using Google Meet due to the Covid-19 pandemic at SMAN 3 Jambi about "Students' perceptions of learning English using the Google Meet application in tenth grade of Senior High School Number 3 Jambi City". According to Creswell (2010:15) "Qualitative research methods are research desain based on the philosophy of postpositivism, used to examine the state of natural objects, (as opposed to experimental) where the researcher is the key instrument, sampling of data sources is purposive and snowball, technique collection by triangulation (combined), data analysis is inductive/qualitative and qualitative research results emphasize the importance of generalization." Lindlof and Taylor (2002:6) stated that qualitative research is a research methodology to explain explanatory information in the form of oral and written forms of observed objects and personalities.

Therefore, the researcher uses a phenomelogy research desain in this thesis which is based on students' experiences about learning English using the Google Meet application.

Phenomenology research desain is an approach to qualitative research that focuses on the commonality of living experiences within a particular group. The basic purpose of this approach is to explain the nature of each phenomenon (Creswell, 2013). For George, a valid word in phenomenological research is

"explain." The researcher's purpose is to explain the phenomenon as accurately as possible, without pre-determined framework conditions, but to remain true to the facts. Welman and Kruger (1999, p. 189) "Phenomena want to understand social and psychological phenomena from the perspective of the people involved." Husserl's philosophical phenomenology provided Alfred Schultz with a starting point and applied it "in the way ordinary members of society shape everyday life" (Gubrium & Holstein, 2000, pp. 488–489).

3.2 Setting of the Research

The research school is located on Jl. Teacher Mukhtar Jambi City. This school was chosen as the research location by considering several factors. First, the school is located in an Teacher Training (PPL). Therefore, researchers are interested in conducting research to find out how students' perceptions of learning English using Google Meet are. Second, the researcher is already familiar with the students. In addition, it is easier to get data because teachers are open to research.

3.3 Subjects of the Research

The subjects of this study were students of class X MIPA 2 SMAN 3 Jambi pppppCity and the number of students in the class was 33 students. In this study, the researcher was use Purposive sampling is by interviewing several students involved in this study and selected six students as participants consisting of two students from low scores, two students from medium scores, and two students from high scores.

Purposive sampling including the primary study sample in the synthesis is one way to achieve a manageable amount of data. The purpose of this study is to explain the development and application of a sampling framework for synthesizing qualitative evidence of student communication for learning English using the Google Meet application.

3.4 Instrument of the Research

Instrument of the research is a tool or media to get research data. (Burns, 2010) instrument as a means of collecting data should be rigorously designed and manufacturing in such a way that generating empirical data as is. In constructing this research, the researcher will used interviews for collecting data. The researcher started the research by giving some question to be interviewed the students one by one them.

In qualitative research design, the instrument or research tool is the researcher himself who is expected to be able to complete the data found through the use of observation, interviews and documentation. Glesne and Peshkin (1992: 130) state that data analysis is a method of classifying and filtering data based on participant ratings and statements. Stainback of Gare's Journal (2018: 35) states: "Data analysis is very important to the qualitative research process create and evaluate hypotheses and assertions to recognize, research, and understand connections and concepts in your data. Data analysis Executed during and after data collection is complete.

Esterbeg (2002) defines the interview as follows. "a meeting of two people to exchange information and ideas through questions and responses, resulting in communication and the construction of shared meaning about a particular topic".

An interview is a meeting of two people to exchange information and ideas through question and answer, so that meaning can be constructed in a particular topic.

Interviews are used as a data collection technique to conduct a preliminary study to find problems that must be investigated, but also if you want to know things from the respondents more deeply. This data collection technique is based on self-reports or self-reports, or not on personal knowledge and beliefs.

3.5 Technique of Collecting Data

Based on the theories above, it can be argued that the data analysis is the process of systematically searching and collate the data obtained from interview, field notes, and documentation by way of organizing data into categories, describing the units into synthesize, organize into pattern and others. In this study, researcher obtained the Technique Collecting Data with the following steps:

- 1. Make interview questions
- 2. Listen the recording back interview by listen the recording back, the researcher can conclude and evaluate carefully the results of interview with students.
- 3. Make transcripts/verbatim, interview transcript is the result of interview which is converted into a written document.
- 4. Read back the results of transcripts, by re-reading the scripts, it will be easier for the researcher to identify whether there are still things that have not been written down.
- 5. Find where issues (topics) that stand out and appear repeatedly in the transcripts, and then grouped according to the problem of topic. Do not forget to refer to notes made during the interview process take place.

6. Make coding transcription of results by grouping issues/topic, coding is a word or short phrase that has a figurative meaning or a sign that is concise and directly aimed at the message.

3.6 Technique of Analyzing Data

Data is obtained from sources, using various data collection techniques (triangulation), and is carried out continuously until the data is saturated. with continuous observation can result in very high data variation. Therefore, researchers often have difficulty in conducting the analysis. Triangulation is defined as a data collection technique that combines various data collection techniques and existing data sources.

The analysis is carried out on the data from the preliminary study or secondary data used to determine the research focus. The following are the steps of data analysis:

1. Data Collection

In qualitative research Data collection by observation, in-depth interviews, documentation, or a combination of both (triangulation). In the early stages, researchers carry out a general survey of the situation under investigation. This allows researchers to get very large and very different data.

2. Data Reduction

Reducing data means summarizing, selecting and sorting the main things, focusing on the things that are important, looking for themes and patterns. Thus the data that has been reduced will provide a clearer picture, and make it easier for researchers to conduct further data collection.

3. Data Display

After the data is collapsed, the next step is to display the data. In qualitative research, data can be presented in the form of brief descriptions, diagrams, relationships between categories, flowcharts, and so on. In this case, Miles and

Huberman (1984) discovered that "the most common form of data display for past qualitative research data was narrative text." The most common representation of data in qualitative research is the text of the story.

4. Conclusing drawing/ Verivication

According to Miles and Huberman, the fourth step in qualitative data analysis is to draw conclusions. The conclusions presented are preliminary and will change if strong and supporting evidence is not found in the next phase of data collection. However, when researchers return to collect data, the conclusions made are credible if the early conclusions are supported by valid and consistent evidence.

CHAPTER IV

FINDINGS AND DISCUSSION

4.1 Findings

4.1.1 Students' Perception of English Studies Use The Google Meet Application.

Class X Science 2 SMAN 3 Jambi academic year 2021/2022. The question consists of 9 questions. The interview was conducted on January 18, 2022. There are various perceptions about the use of the Google meet application in learning English. It can be seen from the notes that have been analyzed by researchers, it is explained as follows:

Related to the first question about "Have you used the google meet application before?". There are six students who stated that they used the google meet application when the pandemic first appeared when they were still in junior high school follows:

- **Student 1:** Once, When I was in Junior High School after this covid-19 rr pandemic.
- **Student 2:** Once, Yes, sist, once when I was in junior high school number 12 Muaro Jambi.
- **Student 3:** Once, Yes, Sist once when I was in junior high school after this pandemic.
- **Student 4:** Once, yes sist whe I was in junior high school after this pandemic.
- **Student 5:** Once, Yes, Sist once when I was in junior high school after this pandemic.
- **Student 6:** Once, Yes, Sist once when I was in junior high school after this pandemic.

From the analysis of question number one, the researcher concluded that students used the google meet application when they were still junior high school students after the emergence of the covid-19 pandemic.

Related to the second question about "Is the google meet app easy to use during a pandemic by holding virtual meetings for actual meetings? And why?", all of them stated that the Google meet application is easy to use because they can discuss anywhere and anytime, as can be seen from the following interview:

Student 1: It's easy because with google meet we can discuss more easily without having to leave the house

Student 2: Easy, because it is an application that is simple for beginners and easy for everyone to operate

Sudent 3: It's easy, because using Google Meet is more relaxed

Student 4: Yes, because it's more practical

Student 5: It's easy, because by using Google Meet, studying at home is so much easier

Student 6: Easy, because the use of the Google Meet application is not complicated and more practical

From the results of the interview above, the researcher concludes that the Google Meet application is easy to use because it is very practical and can learn from home

Related to the third question about "Have you become more active with google meet in speaking skills? Why?" This shows that five students said yes and one student said no. This can be seen from the results of the interviews as follows:

Student 1: Yes, because they often answer questions or read texts

Student 2: Because when you use Google Meet you don't meet in person, so you can reduce your nervousness

Student 3:That's it, because by discussing with Google Meet, we automatically talk a lot too

Student 4: It's done, because in the Google Meet application we don't meet in person so that it can reduce the feeling of being nervous

Student 5:Yes, because you are trained through answering or reading question

Then, there was one student who said no because he preferred to study face-to-face

Student 6: Not yet, because if you google meet, you don't meet in person, right if you talk about meeting in person

From the analysis of question number three, the researcher concludes that for students, honing their speaking skills can be done when they do not feel nervous because they do not meet in person so that it can reduce the existing nervous feeling. Unfortunately, not all students can hone their speaking skills, one student stated not because they prefer to meet in person

Related to the fourth question about "Do you often hone your speaking skills while studying on Google Meet? Give your opinion!" There were four students who stated that speaking skills were not good if through virtual media because they preferred to learn face-to-face. Meanwhile, there were 2 students who said that honing their speaking skills at Google Meet was quite effective. It can be seen as follows:

- **Student 1:** Not really because to hone my skills I prefer to hone speaking on other platforms
- **Student 2:** Tidak terlalu sering karna lebih enak tatap muka" (Not too often because it's better face to face
- Student 3: Not too often to hone skills, it's better face to face
- **Student 4:** It's a bit rare because the use of Google Meet is only when studying online

Meanwhile, students who have improved their speaking skills using the Google Meet application are shown as follows:

- **Student 5:** Once, because I think honing your speaking skills on Google Meet is quite effective
- **Student 6:** Already, learning uses google meet, my teacher often asks when there is a question and answer session

From the results of the interviews above, the researchers concluded that the google meet application is not conducive to students who will hone their speaking skills because students prefer face-to-face because the interaction between teachers

and students is more intense. However, there are also students who feel that they have practiced their speaking skills on Google Meet because there are questions and answers

Related for the fifth question about "How important do you think it is to learn English? Give your opinion!", the results can be seen as follows:

- **Student 1:** This is very important, because English is an international language which is used everywhere
- **Student 2:** Very important, because English is a universal language used throughout the world
- **Student 3:** Very important because we need English and the opportunity to get a job is bigger
- **Student 4:** It is important, because English is an international language that is a prerequisite for entering college
- **Student 5:** It's very important, in this era of globalization, I really need to feel left behind if I don't master English
- **Student 6:** Important, because English is now a requirement to go to college and work.

For the the results of the interviews above, the researcher concludes that English is a universal language where and whenever we need English, both for entering college, official school and English is a lifestyle.

Related for the sixth question about "Is virtual learning more effective than face-to-face learning in class? Why? From the results of interview shown that there were all students have the same answer. It results shows as follows:

- **Student 1:** No, because virtual learning is more awkward and less effective
- **Student 2:** No, because it's more difficult to understand lessons when virtual than face to face
- **Student 3:** Virtual learning is not effective, it is more effective when face to face, because when face to face it is easier to understand
- **Student 4:** No, with limited communication and interaction, it certainly affects the way we learn
- **Student 5:** No, because virtual learning does not interact directly
- **Student 6:** Less effective because they do not interact directly with the teacher and cannot ask questions directly

From the results of the interviews above, the researchers concluded that virtual learning is not effective, especially learning English, students feel less effective because there is no interaction between students and teachers and students with students themselves.

Related to the seventh question about "Do you find it easy when learning English with the Google Meet application? If not, give your opinion!". From the results of the interview, it can be seen that there are 3 students who find it easy to learn there are also 3 students who have difficulty in learning English. The results show as follows:

Student 1: Yes, I think it's easier because learning is more interactive

Student 2: It's quite easy because with Google Meet we are automatically encouraged to discuss and interact

Student 3: Yes, it's easy, because what you learn can still be understood

While the results of students who have difficulty in learning through the google meet application are shown as follows:

Student 4: No, it's harder to learn through virtual

Student 5: It's not easy because it's not understood

Student 6: No because I often go out at meetings because the network is not stable

From the results of the interview above, the researcher concludes that each student has the ability and power of a different level of understanding, there are students who find it easy to learn English using the Google Meet application, there are also students who find it difficult because of network constraints and so on.

Related to the eighth question about "what are advantages and disadvantages of learning English is a google meet application? What is your opinion!" From the results of the interview, it can be seen that all students have the same answer, they are hampered by signals and quotas. The results show the following:

- **Students 1 :** If the excess is comfortable because if there is a speaking test and others, it is clearer and more relaxed. For shortcomings if the material is missed it becomes difficult to understand
- **Students 2:** The advantage is that it is more practical to do it anywhere, the disadvantage is that sometimes the signal is bad so that the class is disturbed
- **Students 3 :** The advantage is that it is more relaxed because we can choose a comfort place to study if the drawback is network problems which often become obstacles
- Students 4: The advantage is that it can practice speaking when conducting google meet, if the drawback is that if the network is less stable, it can go in and out and become unfocused
- **Students 5 :** For advantages, there is no need to write again, while disadvantages are more difficult to understand
- **Student 6:** The advantages are because it is more relaxed and the disadvantages are less understood

From the results of the interview above, the researcher concludes that Students feel more comfortable because learning to use Google Meet is more relaxed and they can practice their speaking skills, while almost all of the respondents answered that they are constrained by signals so that they seem difficult in learning English.

Related to the nineth question about "When using the Google Meet application do you experience problems in learning? Give your reasons!" From the results of the interview, it can be seen that all students have the same answer, they are constrained by signals and quotas. The results show the following:

- Student 1: Yes, there are some lessons that are hard to understand
- **Student 2:** The problem I'm experiencing is when the signal doesn't support it, it disconnects
- **Student 3:** The obstacles are more towards communication and interaction that are more difficult, differences in networks and devices are also obstacles
- **Student 4:** There are times when Google Meet is often affected by network disturbances and makes learning time less comfortable
- Student 5: Yes, signal problems and blackouts
- **Student 6:** Sometimes experiencing problems because suddenly the internet quota runs out

From the results of the interview above, the researcher concludes that All students experience problems when the electricity goes out, and students also feel hampered in communication and interactions between fellow students and student teachers are also hampered because suddenly the internet quota runs out.

Based on the results of the interview above, the researchers found various kinds of student perceptions, where there are positive and negative perceptions because Google Meet really has its own advantages and disadvantages. For positive perceptions, students can study at home without having to go to school and students can find a comfortable place when learning begins, while for negative perceptions, students are less likely to record learning material so that student notes are incomplete

4.2 Discussion

Based on the interview result the researcher found how was the students' perception at the first grade students of SMAN 3 Jambi in Academic year 2021/2022. It describe as follows:

Related to the first quuestion of the interview research, the researcher concluded that all students had used our Google Meet application, they were still in junior high school and had been facilitated by quotas by their schools because at that time the Covid-19 epidemic had just emerged. And when they enter high school, they still use the Google Meet application as a learning medium that has been facilitated by the school and it depends on the teacher who wants to use which learning media. However, English teachers in particular use English learning media

using the Google Meet application, where this application has a long time so that it can study conducively until the subject is finished.

Related to the second question of the interview research, the researcher concluded that students said learning to use the Google Meet application was very easy, they could learn a language anywhere and anytime and with google meet students not only heard voices but also, they could face to face virtually. This is one way teachers and students can stay face-to-face during the pandemic. And then, students enjoy the learning process. because there is no burden to study at home, flexible time, not tired like at school and can also make them more confident in learning English

Related to the third question of the interview research, the researcher concluded that, for students, appreciating their speaking skills can be done when they do not feel nervous because they do not meet in person so that they can reduce the existing nervousness. Unfortunately not all students can hone their speaking skills, one of the students stated that they have not because they prefer face-to-face because it is more effective to learn at school because the interaction is more certain, online learning does not get enough knowledge.

Related to the fourth question of the interview, the Google Meet application interview is not conducive for students who will hone their speaking skills because students prefer face-to-face so that the interaction between teachers and students is more intense because during this pandemic the effectiveness of using Google Meet in online learning for speaking skills is very important. Students stated that learning to speak using google meet in online learning was less effective. However, there

are also students who feel that they have practiced their speaking skills on Google Meet because there are questions and answers.

Related to the fifth question of the interview, English is a universal language where and whenever we need English, whether to enter college, official school or English is a lifestyle where they feel left behind when they cannot master English. Because of that they are very enthusiastic about learning English during the Covid-19 pandemic because this is the only way to keep learning due to circumstances that do not allow them to go and study at school.

Based on the results of interview number sixth, virtual learning is not effective, especially learning English, students feel less effective because there is no interaction between students and teachers and students with students themselves. Related to the effectiveness of using google meet in online learning English during the Covid-19 pandemic. The students stated that learning English using google meet in online learning was less effective. They said that it is more effective to learn in school because the interactions are more certain, in online learning they do not get enough knowledge.

From the result of the interview above seventh question of the interview, that each student has different abilities and understanding power, there are students who find it easy to learn English using the Google Meet application, there are also students who find it difficult due to network constraints and so on. From the results of interviews, it can be concluded that more students feel that online learning does not improve their ability to learn English, this is due to the lack of interaction between teachers and students and it is not as if they are face-to-face in the

classroom. There are some students who agree if their English skills improve because they want to study independently at home.

From the answers above, the researcher found it is clear that the advantages and disadvantages of the google meet application. Almost all students asked the same thing, they mentioned the shortcomings or obstacles of this google meet is a difficult network because there are students who have problems with the network when they are at home or when the lights go out. There are also students who say that when the network is lost, they automatically disconnect when they are in a meeting room and that is one of their obstacles in using the Google Meet application, not only that, google meet also has advantages, they say that using the google meet application is easier to use because it can be anytime and anywhere they also feel more relaxed in learning google meet because they can find a comfortable place when studying.

Related to the nineth question of the interview, the association aspect when they learn English using the Google Meet application. In today's modern era, many people want instant and practical work. Students say that learning English is one of the important skills they can learn English using Google Meet anywhere and anytime. The last is about the obstacles to learning English using the Google Meet application, they prefer face-to-face learning because they find it easy to understand and can interact directly with the teacher if they are hampered by the network at Google Meet. Each student stated that they were learning face-to-face because they were free to be creative, whether it was speaking skills, they were free to write on the blackboard or so on.

Based on the results of interviews, researchers found students' perceptions of learning English by using the Google Meet application, that most of the students' English learning at X IPA 2 was effective because they were less effective because they could not meet face to face directly. This application is more practical because it can be used at any time but due to signal constraints it becomes more difficult when using this application.

The Google Meet application is an alternative media for students and teachers when learning English during this pandemic, because by using the Google Meet application learning becomes easier, practical, fun for students and teachers. The Google meet application can also hone their skills in learning English. The teacher teaching in the meeting room provides material in the form of power points, the teacher also gives them the practice of speaking, reading, listening and even writing. But it is unfortunate that this kind of learning is not conducive because there is no direct interaction. Each student has different abilities and understanding so that students prefer to learn directly.

The researcher also found data that in fact, the students liked English lessons because it was needed when they entered college, official school or to apply for a job. The researcher also found that there were some students who found it easy when learning English using this application because the level of the material was easy to understand.

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1. Conclusion

After analyzing the data, the researcher draws several conclusions, as the following:

The use of the Google meet application in learning English in first grade students of Senior High School Number 3 Jambi has a good influence on learning English. The use of the Google Meet application is more practical, more fun because there are many features such as easier and can be used anywhere, but because of signal constraints, students find it difficult to learn. This proves that the Google Meet application is not effective when learning is virtual, but because of this pandemic everything must be done online. This is due to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic. This statement is supported by the results of interviews with students who find it difficult to signal when learning English using the Google Meet application

The Google meet application can be implemented when the teacher wants to teach material, can share the screen with students to show the learning material. Sometimes the teacher also gives time for students to interact in the meeting room such as conversations, dramas and so on.

The google meet application is also not effective when there are students whose homes are far from the city center so that students experience problems with signaling and feel left out of material.

There are difficulties based on student perceptions that the researchers found, such as Students feel disturbed by signals that like to disappear because when

they disappear they immediately disconnect from the meeting room so that students when absent by the teacher are considered absent.

5.2 Suggestions

After analyzing the data and making conclusions, the researcher has several suggestions for schools, teachers, and students so that learning English using the Google Meet application for first graders at SMAN 3 Jambi is carried out regularly so that students can practice their English language skills. But face-to-face learning will be more conducive to the development of students learning English. Some suggestions are addressed to:

1. School

Schools must provide instruments that are in accordance with today's modern era to improve students' knowledge and creativity in learning English.

2. Teacher

Especially for English teachers, you should consider using the Google Meet application because students prefer face-to-face learning compared to online. English teachers must provide the simplest media and appropriate techniques for students in learning English at google meet. Then the last one is the teacher must have more time to train students' English skills in learning using the Google Meet application, continue to use google meet even though teaching and learning activities are carried out face-to-face or using a hybrid system.

3. Student

The students should be more active in learning in the classroom, students should not be afraid or embarrassed to learn English. Because the use of the Google

Meet application in learning English is the right tool during this pandemic. In addition, teachers and students must have motivation in learning, especially English. Teachers can provide support to students to use the Google Meet application because it is the right learning method during this pandemic.
