

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

This research was carried out to determine the students' vocabulary mastery. Based on the information gathered from the 50-question vocabulary exam given to 33 students and the findings of the research, the researcher has come to the conclusion that the majority of students still encounter some difficulties while trying to respond to the questions. Along with a mean score of 54,48, the students' total score on the vocabulary mastery test in the English subject was 1794. It implies that students struggle with understanding vocabulary is good enough.

However, it could be resolved, if teachers continually improve their methods for teaching English vocabulary to make studying more engaging and enjoyable for the students. In addition to being an important aspect of learning activities, motivation tends to come both inside and outside of the student. Students who are driven to learn both internally and externally will be extremely enthusiastic to provide the best learning outcomes. Students may further develop the vocabulary of English by memorizing every new word they hear and discover.

5.2 Suggestion

Considering the findings of the research, it is suggested to:

1. For students, ought to be able to increase interest in learning to increase vocabulary mastery.
2. For English teacher, suggested to be able to pay more attention to and guide their students who struggle to comprehend lessons in English, especially in vocabulary mastery.

3. For other researcher, suggested to conduct research on other learning methods or models that related to vocabulary mastery to improve students' vocabulary mastery.
