

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the results of the research and discussion that has been described, the following results are obtained:

1. There is a difference in learning outcomes of English vocabulary learning between the experimental group using the Memrise application and the control group taught without using the Memrise application as evidenced by the experimental group data with a sig value, (2 tailed) = 0.001 while sig 0.05 then ($0.001 < 0.05$) then H_0 is accepted, this shows that there is a significant increase in the mastery of student vocabulary using the Memrise application at SMA Negeri 6 Muaro Jambi Academic Year 2024.
2. Students' English vocabulary learning using the Memrise application is more effective than without using the Memrise application as evidenced by the control group's significance value of $0.207 > 0.05$ while the experimental group's significance value is $0.000 < 0.05$, meaning that the experimental group is more effective in increasing student vocabulary using the Memrise application at SMA Negeri 6 Muaro Jambi Academic Year 2024.

5.2 Suggestions

After the end of the study and this thesis, the researcher has some recommendations, including:

1. For Students

Take advantage of the interactive features offered by Memrise such as quizzes and vocabulary exercises. Discuss new vocabulary with classmates or teachers. These discussions can help deepen understanding and increase motivation.

2. For the English Teacher

Teachers should consider integrating Memrise into regular lesson plans. Create activities that combine the use of the app with classroom activities to improve vocabulary comprehension. Also monitor students' progress by using the report or statistics feature provided by Memrise. Evaluate their progress regularly to determine the effectiveness of the app and make adjustments if needed.

3. For School

It is expected that the school can ensure that all students have access to the necessary devices and internet to use Memrise. Create a forum or discussion group within the school to share experiences and tips on using Memrise. This can increase motivation and build a supportive learning community.

4. For Future Researcher

Never stop encouraging your students and never stop sharing your knowledge to them. Researchers hope that this research will be useful to you as you continue your studies.
